1. Registration of participants:

As for 10 of May, 2008, the following countries provided their applications for participation: Ukraine, Russia, Byelorussia, Bulgaria, Kazakhstan, Slovakia, Slovenia, Poland, Moldova, Lithuania, Romania, Hungary, Czech Republic, Macedonia, Serbia. The overall number of participants – 87, M-45, W-42.

2. Details of the Championship:

Date of the Championship – 13-16 June 2008

Venue – Moldova, Vadul-lui-Voda, approx. 18 from Chisinau, on the bench of the Dniester river, recreation center "FRANZELUTZA".

3. Participation fees

Competitors, Officials, Visitors: 120 Euro per person.

Sunday, 15 June: 3.5 MHz competition, awards ceremony, party

5. Competition rules

International rules for Youth ARDF Championships on the 144 MHz and 3.5 MHz band for the categories W15 and M15 will be applied.

Ranking - individuals and teams.

Only competitors born in 1993 or later are allowed.

Each country may be represented by 2 teams, each being composed as follows: M15 -3, W15 -3. Maximum allowed nr of competitors from a country -12.

6. Classification and awards

According to IARU ARDF Rules:

Individual classifications: I-III places – medals, diplomas, valuable prize.

Team classifications: I-III places – medals, diplomas, cups.

Power - around 3 W

Antenna – vertical wire, 7.5 m long

Frequencies – from MOE to MO5 – 3,56 MHz, MO – 3,575 MHz

144 MHz

Power - 1 W


Antenna – circle dipole, horizontal polarization

Frequencies - from MOE to MO5 – 145,7 MHz, MO – 144,2 MHz
